Our trains run to memorable destinations across Britain behind historic steam or heritage diesel locomotives, and whether you are heading to the seaside, a cathedral city, or over the Settle and Carlisle line, the journey matters as much as the destination. Open the window and feel these remarkable machines at work.

The Locomotives

Our superbly restored express steam locomotives are some of the last working examples of their type, maintained at our historic Tyseley locomotive works and run on Britain's main line, not as museum pieces but as living machines. Selected journeys are hauled by heritage diesel locomotives through some of Britain's most rewarding scenery.

The Hospitality

Our coaches range from comfortable standard class to authentic vintage Pullman Cars and First Class carriages, all with generous picture windows. Pullman passengers enjoy a full English breakfast, Sunday lunch, afternoon tea or 4-Course Dinner, while First Class features coffee & croissants and afternoon tea or on selected journeys a 2-Course evening meal on the return. Standard class passengers are welcome to bring a picnic, with beers, soft drinks and other refreshments also available from our buffet.

The People & The Routes

Our stewards, footplate crew and support team are largely long standing volunteers, and their professionalism and quiet enthusiasm create an atmosphere that is both relaxed and distinctive.

We run to York, Llandudno, Scarborough, Plymouth and Portsmouth, and operate the popular *Shakespeare Express* to, and *Shakespeare Pullman* from, Stratford-upon-Avon. New this year are routes through Central Wales and over the Cambrian mountains to the Talylyn Railway, founded by pioneers closely connected to our own history.

You will be seated at tables of 2 or 4, laid with crisp white linen, fresh flowers and fully dressed with crockery and glassware. As you relax in the comfort of your seat, a Full English Breakfast will be served alongside tea, coffee, water or orange juice.

After several hours sightseeing at your destination, you will be welcomed back onboard with a drinks service, followed by your 4-Course evening dinner.

Our food is freshly prepared onboard by our chefs and served at your seat, while you relax and watch the British countryside passes by your picture windows, accompanied by the sound of the locomotive working hard.

We offer seasonal menus, including festive menus on our Christmas trains, so if you travel several times through the year you will be sure to enjoy food crafted from the finest British ingredients, celebrating unique flavours of the season.

Seating at a guaranteed table for 2 people is available in Pullman, subject to availability and payment of a supplement.

Seating to Suit Every Traveller

First & Standard Class

First Class passengers will travel in one of our British Railways Mk1 carriages at tables for 2, tables for 4 or up to 6 people in a private compartment. Reservations at tables for two and for private compartments may be made on payment of a supplement.

Upon boarding, you will be served a light breakfast of croissants and pastries, with tea and coffee. On the return journey, an afternoon tea will be waiting at your table for you to enjoy as the countryside and townscapes pass by your window.

On some journeys, there will be the option of dining or non-dining First Class seats. The dining option will feature the light breakfast, as well as a 2-Course evening meal.

In Standard Class, seating is arranged around tables for four people. You can pre-order bacon rolls for the morning or an afternoon tea, for an additional charge, each delivered to your seat, with a cup of tea or coffee. A buffet car is also available onboard offering light refreshments including snacks, tea and coffee, soft drinks, wines and beers.

BR (W) 4073 'Castle' Class Locomotive
Built in 1950 by British Railways to Charles Collett's 1923 Great Western Railway design. Hauled the final steam service out of Paddinginton in 1965.

GWR 4073 'Castle' Class Locomotive
Built in 1936 and so is an authentic Great Western Railway locomotive. Beat Clun Castle's record for shortest timed journey between Plymouth and Bristol.



The return journey takes a contrasting route along the Welsh Marches, offering sweeping views and historic railway towns as the train heads back to the Midlands.



Embark on a classic mainline, steam-hauled, adventure this Spring that traverses two of Britain's most well known routes - the West Coast Mainline over Shap Fell and the famous Settle & Carlisle.

This memorable journey heads North West to Carlisle, a 2000 year old city with plenty of history to discover. While the city is famous for Hadrian's Wall, there is much more besides including the Cathedral, Castle and several museums and galleries all for you to explore.

The route will see the train tackle Shap Fell, long regarded as one of the great challenges of the West Coast Main Line and a highlight for railway enthusiasts. The Cathedrals Express heads to the North East and the Cathedral city of Newcastle for the first time, since *7029 Clun Castle* departed the city in 1967.

The train will journey from Birmingham, through the East Midlands, before steaming into Yorkshire and stopping at the historic city of York. Here passengers can choose to alight to stroll down the famous ‘Shambles’, marvelling at York Minster or visiting the admission-free National Railway Museum. Passengers can also join at York for steam hauled trip to Newcastle and return.

The Talylyn Railway Preservation Society (TRPS) was formed in Birmingham in October 1950 and we are proud to be connected with this pioneer organisation through our own founder, Pat Whitehouse who was the first secretary to the TRPS and so involved with the voluntary preservation railway movement from the outset, later going on to found our own charity, Vintage Trains Charitable Trust.

To celebrate this connection and the Talylyn's 75th Anniversary of the world's first volunteer run train service, join us as we create history by running our inaugural train over the scenic Cambrian Coast line this April.

The Cambrian Coast Express will take passengers from the Midlands to Tywyn or Pwllheli on the Cambrian Coast, featuring;

- Double headed Talylyn Railway special train with both original locomotives: No. 1 'Talylyn' and No. 2 'Dolgoch'

50 years ago D1015 'Western Champion' operated her final trains of a British Railways career, spanning 13 years of working across the Western Region from depots such as Old Oak Common and Laira.

To celebrate this anniversary, we have created *The Golden Hind*, a train that will take this famous locomotive across the Midlands, Great Western Mainline and to the South West, recreating scenes from the 60s and 70s where you could see her at the head of expresses across the Western Region.

From the fast running from Paddington over a route described as "Brunel's Billiard Table", to the challenging gradients of South Devon, this journey has everything you could want, to see and hear the diesel hydraulic at its best.

On day one, the train will depart Birmingham heading for London via Oxford. After a brief pause under the magnificent Brunel designed station roof of Paddington, our train will roar out of London and make its way across the country before venturing south to the maritime city of Plymouth. Day two will see the train retrace the route of the previous day, featuring what will be a glorious arrival into Paddington, before continuing on to Birmingham and journey's end.


